Allen University is Having Three Summer School Sessions in 2017! - "Starting Up! Keeping Up! Catching Up! Graduating Early!"

**Columbia, South Carolina** – A robust schedule has been developed at Allen University for Summer School this year. Allen University will conduct the following three Summer sessions:

- Maymester (3 weeks)      May 15<sup>th</sup> - June 1<sup>st</sup>
- Summer I (4 weeks)      June 5<sup>th</sup> – June 29<sup>th</sup>
- Summer II (4weeks)      July 3<sup>rd</sup> – July 27<sup>th</sup>

If you know a high school senior who is looking for early college credits, if you want to raise your GPA, want to graduate on schedule, or graduate early, Allen University (AU) is the place to be this summer. Costs are \$300 per credit hour, and Room & Board is \$900 per session if taking a minimum of 6 credits.
